- **LOJO Orchard Lease** Kuntz provided an update on the LOJO Orchard Lease. The Regional Port will enter into a lease agreement with Andy Feil. The lease contains an early termination provision in the event the Regional Port needs the property for economic development purposes.
- **Chelan Airport Blue Ribbon Panel** Kuntz reviewed a list of potential citizens to serve on the Chelan Airport Blue Ribbon Committee. Directors will each submit their top three choices. Kuntz will confer with Director Turner on the final selections.
- Chelan County PUD 5th Street Campus Redevelopment Project Kuntz reviewed the PUD's 5th Street Campus Redevelopment project and how the Regional Port may be involved in the RFP process. The Board expressed initial support for an increased role for the Regional Port.
